Kidderminster Town Hall Transformation Project Update

Funded by UK Government

Work is now underway on the new podium outside the Town Hall (see photos below). This new podium will give access to the two previously separate buildings that comprise the Town Hall, entering via the new atrium and courtyard.

The Town Council staff made a welcome return to the building in June, having been based at Wyre Forest House whilst the Town Hall has been closed. A temporary office has been made available within the Town Hall whilst contractors remain on site and work is still being carried out. Access for staff is currently limited, as there is a lot of decoration and external works currently being carried out before we reopen to the public in Autumn.

Cleaning, restoration and conservation of paintings





We were delighted to welcome Sarah Bayliss, an independent art restoration consultant, to the Town Hall to meet some of our research volunteers. She gave a presentation showing us the various processes involved in cleaning, restoration and conservation of historical paintings. The volunteers were particularly keen to hear about her ongoing work on the King Charles I portrait as part of our lottery funded historical project and Sarah certainly brought it to life with before and after images. We are all looking forward to the re-hanging of the restored portrait when it is returned to its rightful place in the King Charles Room and to sharing the story of how the painting came to reside at the Town Hall.
